An unpaid carer is anyone who is looking after a family member, friend, or neighbour who, due to disability, physical or mental health condition, illness, or addiction, cannot cope without support.

We offer practical support, information and signposting to enable carers to lead healthy and fulfilled lives. **To access our support the carer must be over 18 years old.**

What we offer:

Helpline and email- available Monday to Friday, 9 -5. Identifying carers needs and challenges and supporting them to make options and choices to meet those needs. Listening and understanding and offering information and signposting.

Well-being activities and events - to assist with carer health and wellbeing.

Awareness raising and personal development- including First Aid.

Community Engagement- including regular social media updates, drop ins and peer support groups.
